MBACSWP Membership Criteria

1. Dedicated staff member(s) – defined at least $\frac{3}{4}$ time OR job sharing/joint responsibility between two members
2. Three consecutive years within the top 30 nationally or internationally, as ranked in one or more of the following: Business Week, US News & World Report, Wall Street Journal, Economist, Financial Times—ranking to include Part-time and/or EMBA
3. Preference given to schools that provide services to both MBA alumni AND Part-Time OR EMBA students
4. Location — preference based on location to broaden diversity on a global basis or US regional basis located in a major city where we do not have a presence
5. Part-Time/EMBA/Alumni — differentiated services that are promoted as such on a school’s website
